We have found the Bible to be relevant to our lives because it is God's Word. It not only speaks with authority and clarity about this life, but also about the life to come.

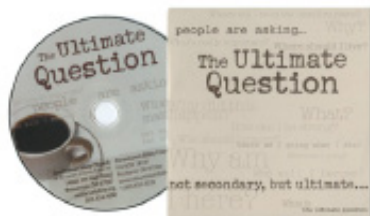

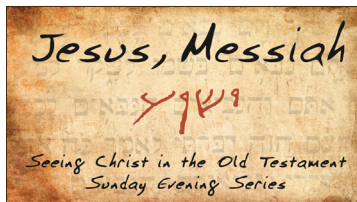
